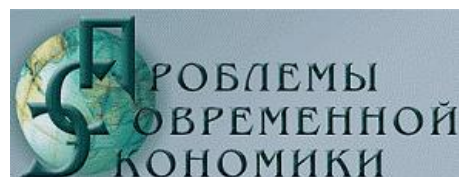
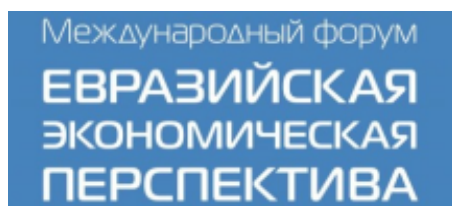

The papers are called from: leading specialists of enterprises and organizations, staff of education establishments and scientific organizations of Russia and foreign states, as well as postgraduate students and students of all enrollment statuses.

Conference format: **mixed**.

The collected papers shall be **published** as per results of the Conference. All the articles will be entered in the System of the **Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI)**.

Sending printed materials and letters of recognition/certificates for the participants shall be paid separately based on the preliminary approval of postage.

The conference abstracts shall contain as follows:

1. Statement of the researched scientific problem;
2. Justification of its validity;
3. Methods of scientific research used by authors;
4. Main results of research;
5. Value of results received.

- **PROVIDED THE CONTACT FORM HAS BEEN FILLED**, the participant e-mails his/her paper to konf3410@mail.ru. **No article will be accepted without prior registration with the contact form.**
- The applications will be rejected (**applications are processed within 3 to 14 days**) unless the declared requirements are not observed. A confirmation letter about approval of an article for further processing shall be e-mailed at approval. **The paper text shall be followed by information about its authors (academic title, academic degree, job position and affiliation, e-mail address).** Text originality shall be at least of 90% (with the plagiarism check system of Antiplagiat VUS, tariff - free). Unless the declared parameter of originality are not observed, the article is subject to rejection.

Requirements to Papers

1. The paper shall comply with the scientific background of the Conference, meet current topic and contain results of deep independent research; it shall not be published before or sent for publishing to other titles.
2. Maximum 4 authors may send one common paper.
3. **A paper not complying with the requirements may be returned to its author for further processing or rejected.**
4. Number of pages in the article – **5-7 pages** (including abstract, key words, information about authors, list of references).
5. Page size A4, orientation: portrait orientation.
6. Times New Roman, font size of the main text - **14**, abstract, keywords, information about authors, footnotes, list of references – **12**.
7. Margins: **top – 1.5 cm, bottom – 1.5 cm, left - 2 cm, right- 1.5 cm.**
8. Line space – **single**.
9. **Paragraph indention – 1.25.**
10. The List of References shall be executed as per requirements of GOST P 7.0.5–2018. Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and drafting rules, GOST 7.80-2000 Bibliographic record. Heading. General requirements and rules, GOST 7.0.5-2008 References. Common Requirements and Rules for Compilation, GOST R 7.0.108-2022 Bibliographic references to electronic documents placed in information and telecommunication networks. General requirements for composition and design.

11. In the text, references shall be marked with the numerical order of the List of Reference. The **reference number** shall be enclosed in square brackets [5, p.16]. At quotation, please use **French quotation marks** («...»).
12. **AFTER THE TEXT OF THE ARTICLE AND THE LIST OF REFERENCE THE INFORMATION ABOUT THE AUTHORS SHALL BE GIVEN BOTH IN RUSSIAN AND ENGLISH (last and first names, academic title, academic degree, job position and affiliation, e-mail address).**

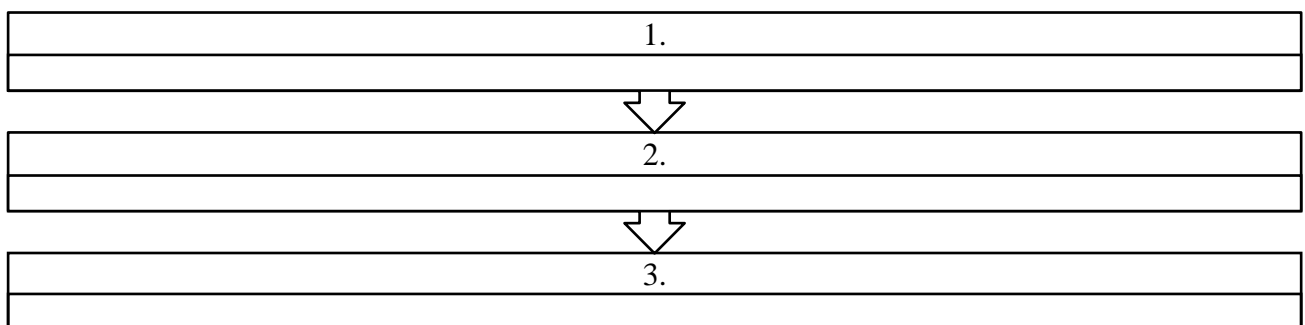


Fig. 1 – Integrated Information System: Steps to Create
